Your task and authority

Berland Hope

- Confirm your assigned duties
- Use the fictional training case
- Verify the result and its history

Learning outcome

Temporary authority is bounded, traceable and revocable.

Choose scope and delegate

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- Choose a suitable active training delegate and only the approved direct permissions.

What to check

Choose an active delegate and only the direct authority approved for the absence. You cannot delegate a permission that you hold only through someone else's delegation.

Dates and timezone

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- Enter exact start/end dates in the labelled application timezone.

What to check

Enter exact start and end values using the application's labelled timezone. Read the period back before saving. A familiar local time is not a substitute for checking the timezone shown on the form.

Inspect the saved grant

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- Save and inspect the scope and expiry.

What to check

Confirm the delegate, permitted actions and expiry. Temporary delegation does not change the person's permanent role. Keep the intended purpose and period understandable.

Rehearse the action

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- Rehearse the permitted action under the delegate account.

What to check

Use the designated training account to check an allowed action within the period. Current direct issuer authority and active accounts remain relevant. An old approval is not a permanent bypass.

Revoke and verify

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- Revoke the delegation and verify loss of delegated authority without changing its permanent role.

What to check

Revoke the training delegation and verify that delegated authority is no longer available. Permanent permissions may still allow other work. Distinguish removal of a delegation from changing a role.

Exceptions and recovery

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- Identify the blocked condition
- Preserve the relevant evidence
- Use the authorized next step

Important boundary

Delegated permission cannot be delegated onward. Inactive accounts or removed direct authority invalidate grants. Do not infer a role-deactivation feature: Custodia roles have no active flag.

Guided practice

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- Work within the assigned role
- Show the resulting state
- Explain one exception

Your exercise

Describe a two-day absence delegation, including timezone and permitted action. Explain what happens after revocation or loss of the issuer's direct authority.

Practice debrief

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- Correct identity and authority
- Traceable result and history
- A justified next step

Expected answer

The delegate is active, scope is limited, dates are exact, no onward delegation is claimed and removal of temporary authority is distinguished from permanent grants.
